## Financial Audit FY 2016-2017

The Consultant reviewed with the Board the performance for quarter ending December 31, 2017. Specific points addressed are as follows:

## **Asset Allocation Study**

The Consultant reviewed with the Board the Asset Allocation Study that was presented back in July, 2017. The Consultant stated that the allocation recommendations made in the report continue to be valid.

## **Emerging Markets**

All the analysis compiled by the Consultant were reviewed. Discussion ensued. M. Fernandez moved and was seconded by T. Roell to defer the decision on entering into this new asset class to the next Regular Meeting. Discussion resumed. The motion was approved unanimously.

## Performance Report

The FIPO Trust had a total market value of \$1,601,698,802 as of December 31, 2017, which represents an increase of \$89.1 million from the September 30, 2017 market value. The overall increase in the Trust's market value was the result of \$44.6 million in net cash flows and an investment gain of \$44.5 million.

#### Watch List

The Consultant recommended that AXA high yield income portfolio be taken off the Watch List as their performance has been consistently above the benchmark for several quarters. Discussion followed. A motion was made by T. Roell and seconded by M. Fernandez to take AXA off the Watch List. The motion was approved unanimously.
